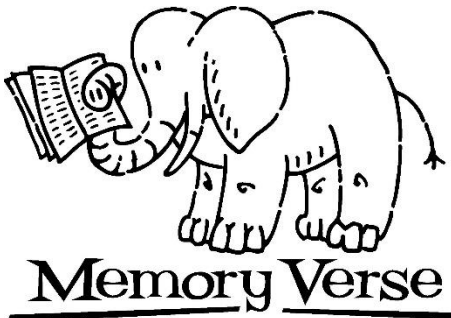
Wednesday Night Small Group

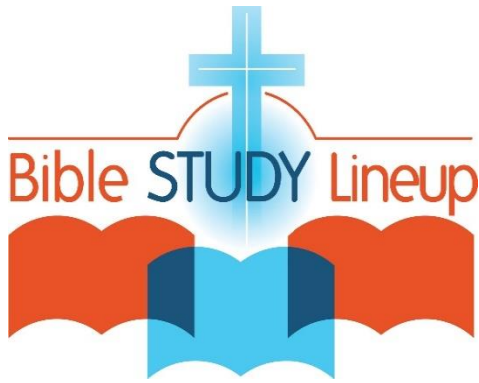
Matthew 13:17
